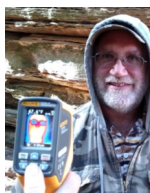

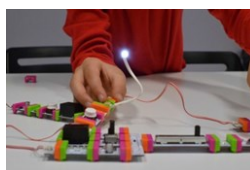

littleBits is a collection of small magnetic circuits which can be put together thousands of ways. Pieces are color coded and intuitive, so anyone can create and build things. They are designed to be used in STEAM projects, activities which combine Art with STEM.
